Q&A during Principal's Address (virtual) for Secondary One students and Parents

Q: Can students bring phone to school?

A: Yes phone is allowed in school but students are not allowed to use the phone other than during the allowed time and place. There are consequences for infringement of the usage of phone other than the permitted time and place. Q: Does secondary One students need to wear MSS uniform on first day of school?

A: Secondary 1 students may put on half uniform during the first week of school. (PE top and uniform shorts/skirts)

Q: Are the school schools black?

A: Yes, black shoes with white socks.

Q: How well did the Express students performed for the past GCE O levels?

Q: Is it possible to join 2 CCAs E.g One Sport One Club CCA

A: As there will be a process of assimilation and adaption to secondary school routines in the earlier part of the year, it is advisable for Sec 1 students to select one CCA as a start. Students can consider a second CCA only if they have shown that they are able to manage and balance both the academic and non-academic expectation.

Q: Can the parent come to the school on this 28th dec to purchase uniforms?

A: Yes they can. For SMM measures, it is advisable for only one parent to accompany one student.

Q: What is the reporting time for School?

A: To cultivate a good habit and routine, please be in school by 7.20am - 7.30am.

Q: Do i need to reapply FAS for my child if my FAS application has already been approved for my other child that is in primary school?

A: If the FAS application for the primary school child is MOE-FAS, you do not need to reapply. You will received a letter from MOE to state that the application has been approved for the children applied for if successful.
