What is Subject-Based Banding (SBB)?

Subject-Based Banding (SBB) is a nation-wide initiative which allows students in the Normal (Academic)普通 (学术)源流 and Normal (Technical)普通 (工艺) 源流 courses to read some subjects at a more demanding level.

What are the possible benefits of taking higher-level subjects?

- Taking subjects at a higher academic level can help students <u>nurture</u> their strengths and be <u>more engaged in learning</u>.
- SBB allows students to <u>challenge themselves</u> and <u>acquire deeper</u> <u>competencies</u> in their area(s) of strength.
- A strong foundation in literacy, numeracy and reasoning will help students be <u>better prepared</u> for various <u>post-secondary</u> <u>progression pathways</u>.

What are the eligibility criteria?

 Eligible N(A) and N(T) course students will receive an 'SBB Offer' based on the following criteria:

Course	PSLE Standard AL	PSLE Foundation AL	Sec 1: Option to offer subject* at
N(A)	AL 5 or better	-	G3
N(T)	AL 5 or better	-	G3 / G2
	AL 6 or better	A	G2

- Some students may find reading subjects at a higher-level challenging. This is natural.
- Students are encouraged to continue with the higher-level subjects until the end of Sec 2, as students* do need time to adjust to the higher academic demands.

- Our school will <u>monitor students' progress</u> in the higher-level subjects, as well as overall progress in all subjects.
- Our school is mindful of students' <u>socio-emotional and academic</u> <u>needs</u> and will endeavour to provide the necessary support to students to help them cope.


Will my child continue with the higher-level subjects all the way to Sec 4?

- The SBB offer is currently for Sec 1 and Sec 2.
- Your child <u>may continue</u> with the corresponding higher-level subject at <u>Upper Secondary</u> if he/she meets our school's criteria at the end of Sec 2.
- Criteria may vary among subjects, but generally:
 - 75% or higher in the subject;
 - Positive learning attitude to cope with the higher academic demand


