G1	≥75% in the specific subject + subject tr's recommendation	G2, starting from next semester
G2	≥75% in the specific subject + subject tr's recommendation	G3, starting from next semester

## Offering Subjects at More Demanding Level (MDL)

 Students <u>currently reading</u> subjects at a MDL may <u>continue</u> to do so in Sec 3 based on the following considerations:

Course	To continue with subject(s) at MDL in Sec 3
G2	Obtain OVERALL ≥ <b>50</b> % for the subject(s) at MDL
G1	at the end of Sec 2

## Offering Subjects at Less / More Demanding Levels (LDL / MDL)



- Students' subject levels may be adjusted across their secondary school journey.
- If students are unable to cope with their current subject levels, there is flexibility to offer the subject(s) at <u>LDL</u> based on the school's holistic considerations.
- Students who offer subjects at <u>LDL</u> may subsequently offer the subject at <u>MDL</u> level as they gain greater competence and confidence in the subject.
