# Offering Subject(s) at More Demanding Level (MDL)

- Students can offer to take subjects at a MDL based on the following criteria:

Current level	OVERALL results	Option to offer subject at
G1	$\geq 75\%$ in the specific subject + subject tr's recommendation	G2, starting from next semester
G2	$\geq 75\%$ in the specific subject + subject tr's recommendation	G3, starting from next semester



# Offering Subjects at More Demanding Level (MDL)

- Students **currently reading** subjects at a MDL may **continue** to do so in Sec 3 based on the following considerations:

Course	To <u>continue</u> with subject(s) at MDL in Sec 3
G2	Obtain OVERALL <u><math>\geq 50\%</math></u> for the subject(s) at MDL at the end of Sec 2
G1	

# Offering Subjects at Less / More Demanding Levels (LDL / MDL)



- Students' subject levels may be adjusted across their secondary school journey.
- If students are **unable to cope** with their current subject levels, there is flexibility to offer the subject(s) at LDL based on the school's holistic considerations.
- Students who offer subjects at LDL may subsequently offer the subject at MDL level as they gain greater competence and confidence in the subject.
